













## LOCATION

The area where the WRC 2025 will be held is located in a mountainous area in the northern interior of Spain, in the Sierra de Neila and the Sierra de Urbión, belonging to the Iberian System.

The area has sufficient infrastructure to accommodate both participants and organizers. At the same time, the town of Quintanar de la Sierra, where the Competition Center will be located, has a large capacity campsite where all participants can be accommodated. Next to these facilities there is a large recreational area, ideal for locating the Competition Center, at the foot of the mountain and with large space to install the infrastructure and services involved in the event for a week: services for participants, Free camping and large space to host the competition.

On the other hand, the province of Burgos and the region of Castilla y León are territories full of history, which offer many possibilities of all kinds to the visitor from the cultural aspect, without forgetting their gastronomy, landscapes and sports offer... Good incentives to enjoy the WRC2025 and excursions and visits to the region.

## DATES

Saturday 5th and Sunday 6th July 2025.

Essentially, the dates of the event have been chosen following climatic factors and daylight hours. The area comprises predominantly a continental mountain climate, encompassing large areas of the terrain located above 2,000 metres above sea level. Hence, at this time of year the conditions are the most optimal for the Rogaine World Championships, the weather during this period presents favourable temperatures (between 5°C at night and 30°C during the warmer days) and less chance of rain, although there could be summer storms.


## **HISTORY OF THE AREA**

'Tierra de Pinares' region is a natural region located in the autonomous community of Castile and León, comprising the southeast of the province of Burgos and the northwest of the province of Soria. Bordering La Rioja to the north are the Neila mountain range, Urbión Peak, and the Cebollera mountain range, and bordering the Río Lobos Canyon and the Cabrejas mountain range to the south.

This region is part of a group of 25 municipalities, 17 in Soria and 8 in Burgos, with a total of approximately 16,000 inhabitants. There are some beautiful old towns in the region worth visiting, such as Vinuesa, Pineda de la Sierra, and Neila. The main industries are wood and stone.

Tierra de Pinares region is also known for having a large concentration of necropolises, the Alto Arlanza Necropolis. There are up to six sites within the competition area. The most famous are the Cuyacabras Necropolis and the Revenga Necropolis.

The hydrography is marked by the Duero River, which flows through the region from the southern slopes of Mount Urbión. The abundance of water, derived from mountain rainfall, forms the rivers and streams that flow through the region. The Neila River, a tributary of the Ebro River, also originates in the region.



## REGISTRATIONS

## WRC REGISTRATIONS **OPENING**

Registration will open on 5 December 2024

In the period from 5 to 31 December 2024, registration will be open only to pre-qualified participants recognised by the IRF.

For the rest of the runners, registration will open on January 1rst, 2025, and will close on June 8th.

Registration details:

- Early Registration: January 1 ~ March 15
- Regular Registration: March 16 ~ April 30
- Late Registration: May 1 ~ June 8

The number of entries for WRC2025 is limited to 1,000 competitors.

Teams must be indicated at the time of registration. They may be changed later until the 8th of June, with a fee of 8€.

Team size will be 2 or 3 people.

Any team with a rider under 14 years of age must have at least one rider over 18 years of age.

All participants under 18 years of age must have the permission of their legal guardian to participate in the competition.

Teams are considered to compete in all categories for which they are eligible.

## **SI RENTAL**

SPORTindet cards (SI version 10, 11 or SIAC) will be for rent. The available card for rent will be provided by the organisers, the rental price is €6. Participants who wish to rent the SI cards, shall request it during the registration process.

When collecting the SI rental cards, competitors must leave a deposit of €70. The deposit will be refunded once the SI card is returned to the organisation at the end of the race. Failure to return the item or returning it in poor condition will result in the loss of the deposit paid.

## **CAMPING TENT RENTAL**

Participants who wish to rent them must request it during the registration process until availability runs out



## **COMPETITION TERRAIN AND MAP**

The competition area comprises approximately 150 km2, and is in the Iberian System, a mountain system in the interior of northern Spain. It covers the Neila and Urbión mountain ranges. Its highest points are "Alto de la Campiña" (2,049 m), Muñalba peak (2,073 m) and Tres Provincias peak (2,056 m). Its lowest points are in the towns of Quintanar de la Sierra (1,110 m) and Palacios de la Sierra (1,050 m). You can find the map in <u>mapant</u>.

The aforementioned mountainous area presents a physically demanding terrain, in which the elevation gain to overcome will be the determining factor or at least a quite important factor for the participants. Navigation and strategic skills will be essential to approach and attack the controls if the rogainers want to successfully optimize their race strategy.

Forested areas cover 70% of the map, with pine (Pinus sylvestris) forests being the main floral protagonist, generally quite passable. The open areas are mainly on the summits and are formed by meadows and some more or less stony areas, relatively passable, located mainly in the glacial cirques formed in both mountain ranges. Rock formations are also frequent, which form large, spectacular stone labyrinths. The network of paths, forest tracks and trails is quite extensive, allowing good accessibility to the entire competition map.

Everything described above together with a multitude of hidden places of singular beauty, spread over many points of the terrain form an extremely unique scenario, with a multitude of possibilities to navigate, and at the same time, enhancing a wide range of strategies, making it a very attractive and irresistible area to compete in this sport discipline (rogaining).

The scale chosen for the mapping will be 1:25,000 with an equidistance of 10 meters. The competition terrain covers a virgin mapped area in the field of rogaining and orienteering, meaning that there are no maps of the area. Competitions have never been held on this terrain, therefore no rogainer has an advantage over his opponents in this respect.

The map will be printed on tough, waterproof paper. Biro, whiteboard markers and permanent markers work well on the paper, however highlighters take about 1 minute to dry. Pencil does not work. Covering the map with contact is optional.

## **TECHNICAL INFORMATION**





• The checkpoints will include reflectors.

• Each competitor must wear a SPORTident card. The card shall be worn on the wrist by means of a non-removable bracelet. It must be worn by the competitor from the start until the finish line. Correct fastening/locking will be checked upon entering the starting enclosure or "corral" and at the finish line.

• All runners must wear the race number provided by the organization.

• The course planning it will take place in the HH in Quintanar de la Sierra, from 9 am to 12 am.

• For safety purposes and in accordance with the rules, the teams must always remain together. Team members are required to pass through the controls with a maximum time difference of one minute between the first and last team member.

• The GPS units provided by the organisation include an SOS button. In an emergency the button can be pressed by the participating team. By pushing the SOS button the device sends the geolocation to the organisation and triggers the action protocols.

• Walking poles may be used.

• The organisation will provide a carton, the size of the map (50x70cm) for the strategy time.

## **SUPPLY STATIONS**

A Hash House (HH) refreshment station, offering both liquids and solid food, will be set up near the finish area. For the race, participating teams must anticipate their needs and carry their own supplies during the event or plan their strategy considering the presence of the HH. All liquid refreshment in both HH will be suitable for drinking.

There are several water points in the area, as well as fountains in the village squares. Many of the water points on the course are natural springs and some clean running water. The local people drink the spring water without treatment, however you may want to sterilise it, due to cattle, sheep, goats, horses and donkeys graze in the area. So it's recommended to carry your own water purification tablets. If necessary, due to drought, the organization will add additional artificial refreshment points.

In the town of Neila, a Half-House service will be available, providing liquid refreshments (including hot drinks) and solid snacks (cold). It will be open from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM.

Furthermore, there will be some grocery shops in the map area, where competitors can buy supplies. This shops won't be printed in the map.

## **DESCRIPTION OF PUNCHING SYSTEM**

The **SPORTident (SI)** system will be used to verify passage through the controls. It is mandatory for all runners to register with an SI-card that supports a minimum of 80 registrations due to there will be more than 80 controls. Therefore, the recommended SI-card models are SI10, SI11 and SIAC.

The SPORTident Air system will not be enabled to avoid problems with registering controls on SIAC cards with low battery.

Each team member must carry an SI-card, which will be sealed on the wristband/bracelet provided by the organization. SI-cards can be rented, provided by the organization.

There will be a manual puncher at each control point in case the electronic system does not work.

All teams must carry a **GPS device** provided by the Organization, both to improve safety during the race and to allow the broadcast of the event. Live transmission will be carried out, with a delayed broadcasting start.

## REGULATIONS

The 2025 Rogaining World Championships will follow the rules established by the IRF, entitled <u>"INTERNATIONAL ROGAINING FEDERATION RULES OF ROGAINING"</u>.

For teams with a participant under 18 years old, there must be an adult team member (+18 years old).


Any team found to be using the internet or other maps during the planning time of 3 hours before the start, or on the course, will be disqualified. GPS capable devices, altimeters or pedometers are not permitted on the course

#### Mandatory Equipment: (approved by IRF)

- Per team:
  - A mobile phone, fully charged and sealed
  - An emergency blanket
  - A GPS device (provided by the organization)
- Individual:
  - A whistle

#### **Recommended Equipment:**

- A warm long-sleeve top
- A rain jacket
- Capacity to carry one liter of fluid
- A first aid kit (including disinfectant, band-aids, antihistamines, anti-inflammatories, analgesic, etc.)
- Water purification tablets



## **INSURANCE AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**

An insurance covering medical coverage will be included in the registration fee, with Alianz Insurance Company.

First aid medical assistance will be available at the Competition Centre, as well as an ambulance for emergency treatment.

The insurance coverage, the accident response protocol, and the accident report are published and detailed on the website.

## **CANINE RESCUE TEAM**

The organization will have the UCAS DE ARRATE team, a canine rescue team.

During the strategy, each team will be given a cloth handkerchief, which they must keep close to their body until the start of the race to capture the person's scent. Afterward, they will be collected and placed in sealed plastic bags with the team's race number.

If a team needs to be searched for, these handkerchiefs will be used so the dogs can sniff them.



# TRANSPORT

There are several airports relatively close to Quintanar de la Sierra operating international fights.
